VANCOUVER, WA – US Ethanol, LLC (“USE”), today announced, that it is continuing to develop a fuel grade ethanol production facility at the Mint Farm in Longview, WA.

USE has been working closely with Makad Corp., the Project Developer, and with its engineering and procurement partner to redesign the Project so that it will include state of the art efficiencies. The Project design is being revised to incorporate the newest air quality equipment as well as to include the latest technology available for enhancing ethanol production.

The international credit crunch has created issues for the Project senior loan arranger and has extended the time necessary to assemble the lending syndicate. Working with its Project Developer, engineering partners and the senior loan arranger, USE has decided to take this opportunity to redesign the Project to incorporate recently available improvements in efficiency.

“We believe that the recent domestic and international financial upheavals have provided us with an opportunity to use this temporary lull in lending activity to greatly improve the efficiency of our Longview Plant.” said USE Chairman Elie Makad. “We are looking at the long run – this is a marathon, not a sprint,” Makad added.

USE is also closely following developments in cellulosic technology and is considering investing in technologies that involve waste wood and algae as feedstocks for the advanced biofuels of the future. The Mint Farm site is large enough to allow USE to build one or more commercial scale cellulosic ethanol plants once the technology matures.
